 - a. Providing suitable venue, including air conditioning and access to free water
 - b. Suitable equipment, including clocks that can be changed as per FIDE laws of chess
 - c. Suitably qualified arbiter(s) to ensure smooth running of the event
 - d. Plan for promotion of the event
- 3. Trophies for age groups from Under 8 to Under 18 including trophies for female participants
 - a. Trophies must only have Chess Association of Queensland logo on them
- 4. Submitted plan of events and budget to be approved by Chess Association of Queensland.
- 5. Organise and run a Brisbane v Gold Coast Junior Match
 - a. 5 players in Under 8/10/12/14/16/18 + Girls.
 - b. Players selected according to rating on the latest QJ list.
 - c. Notify and communicate with all players selected
 - d. Arrange for team captains on the day

The timeline for tenders will be as follows:

- Tender opens on 8 April, 2019
- Tender closes on 26 April, 2019
- CAQ Council decision made by 3 May, 2019
- Notification of (un)successful tender by 10 May, 2019
