In accordance with the Queensland government's June 4th statement surrounding the re-introduction of club sport, the Chess Association of Queensland is happy to announce that chess clubs and ACF-rated tournaments will be able to resume as of June 8th in a minimised capacity.

Listed below are the Chess Association of Queensland's regulations:

- Events and club meetings cannot have more than 20 people in one location (this is inclusive of arbiters, players, spectators, etc.)
- Events and club meetings must display the COVID Safe Checklist (Link 3)
- Events and club meetings must adhere to all required practises as indicated on the COVID Safe Checklist (Link 3)
- All Club Presidents and Tournament Organisers must check the following documents before hosting their event or club meeting:
