

## **COVID-19 Safe Plan – Queensland Junior Standard and Blitz Chess Championships 2020**

- 1 CAQ staff will model appropriate hygiene behaviour – they will ask participants to wash hands or use hand sanitizer with at least 60% ethanol before and after each round by providing hand sanitizer throughout the venue.
- 2 CAQ staff will wash their hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use hand sanitizer with at least 60% ethanol before and after each round.
- 3 CAQ staff will avoid touching their face – eyes, nose & mouth.
- 4 There will be no shaking of hands between participants before or after a game. This includes high 5's, fist bumps etc.
- 5 CAQ staff will spray each board and pieces with Glen 20 between games.
- 6 CAQ staff will encourage participants to sneeze into a tissue and discard or into the crook of their elbow.
- 7 Under the Qld Chief Health Officer Directive, anyone who is unwell must not attend
- 8 If CAQ staff are feeling unwell they will not be able to officiate and a replacement arbiter will be found.
  - a. If they show any respiratory symptoms or fever they will be asked to get a Covid 19 test. Then self-isolate until you receive the results.
- 9 Social distancing is to be practised wherever possible. Our staff will try to space out players throughout the venue while parents and spectators will not be permitted.
- 10 CAQ staff will adhere to the 1.5m ruling between adults.
- 11 At the start of the round high touch points eg. door handles and draw areas will be wiped down using antibacterial wipes or appropriate cleaner.
- 12 Anyone who is showing symptoms or feeling unwell may be asked to leave by CAQ staff
